Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) provides bus, light rail, and paratransit service throughout Santa Clara County and to Milpitas BART, Berryessa BART, and Caltrain stations.

Fare Information effective January 1, 2019

Table showing VTA Fares for Single Ride, Cash Fares, and PREPAID FARES with various options like 1-hour and 3-day passes.

Adult fares: \$5.00. Youth/18-18: \$1.25. Senior/Disabled: \$1.25. VTA drivers do not carry change.

Seniors (65+) Disabled/Medicare Reduced Fare: To qualify for the Senior/Disabled/Medicare fare, you must present one of the following.

Fares and schedules are subject to change. Holiday Schedule: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.



Caltrain provides rail service from San Francisco and San Jose, with weekday commuter service from Gilroy.

To find out when your next bus or train will depart, check nearby displays or simply call 511 and say "Departure Times."

Bicycles on Transit

Rail/Ferries: Bicycles are allowed on all Bay Area ferries and nearly all rail lines. Exceptions are San Francisco Muni Metro, historic streetcars, and cable cars.

Generally: While bicycles are allowed on most transit services, there are some space limitations and, in some cases, times when bicycles are not allowed on board.
