FAST Connect is an on-demand shared transit service. The service provides rides between designated locations within the Cordelia/Green Valley or Northeast Fairfield zone.

The service is also available between a zone and the Fairfield Transportation Center or Fairfield Civic Center.

For travel outside a zone, FAST Connect will also take a person to the nearest regular bus stop within the zone.

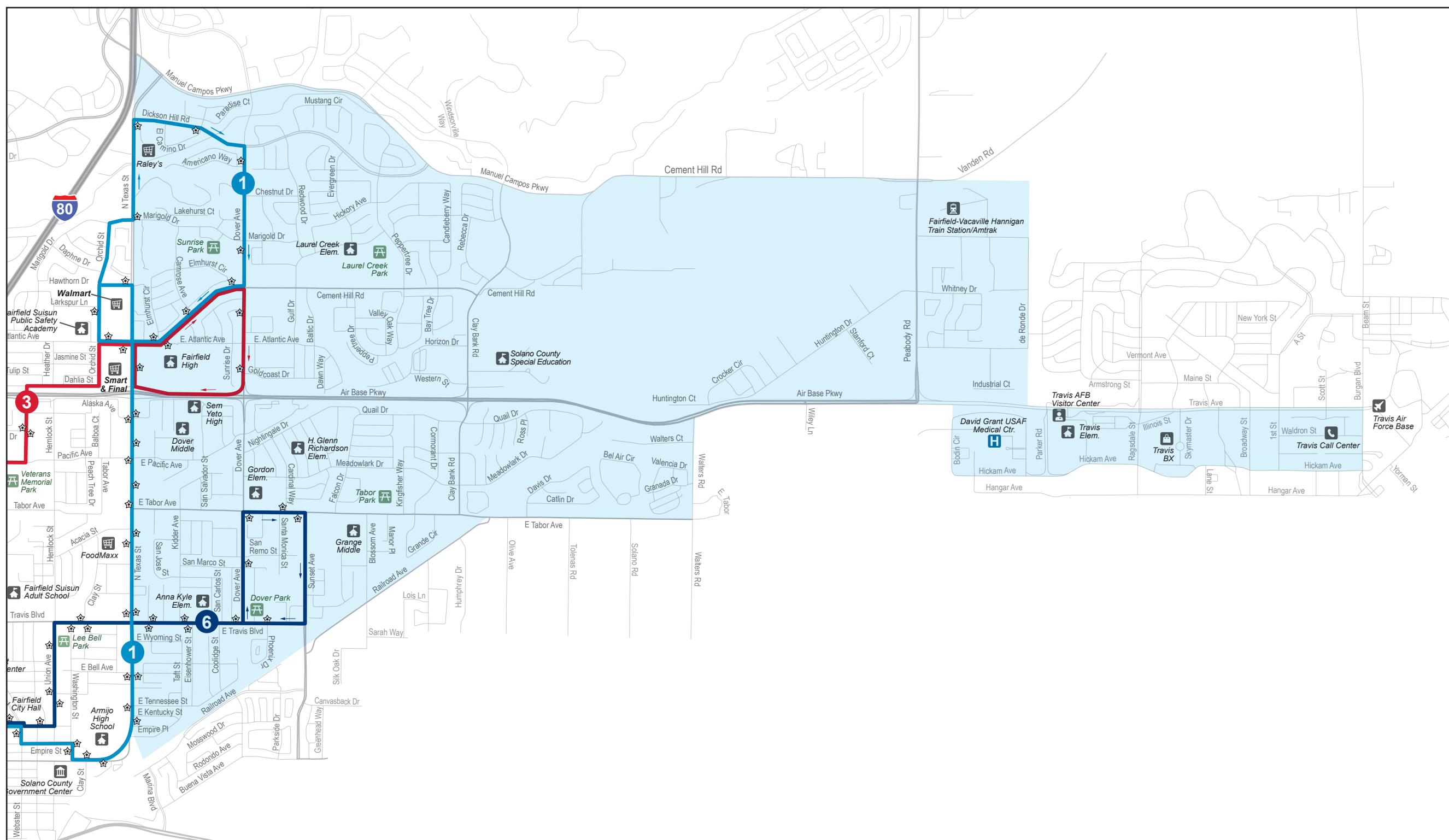
How to use FAST Connect:

- Service hours are Monday-Friday from 6:30 a.m. to 7:45 p.m. and Saturday from 7:30 a.m. to 7:45 p.m.
- Normal local fares apply.
- Average wait times are 20-30 minutes after requesting a ride.
- Vehicles will pick up and drop off at a designated location closest to the requested address.
- Download the Ride Pingo app for iOS or Android, create a free account and schedule a ride. Or, call 707-422-2877 for a ride.

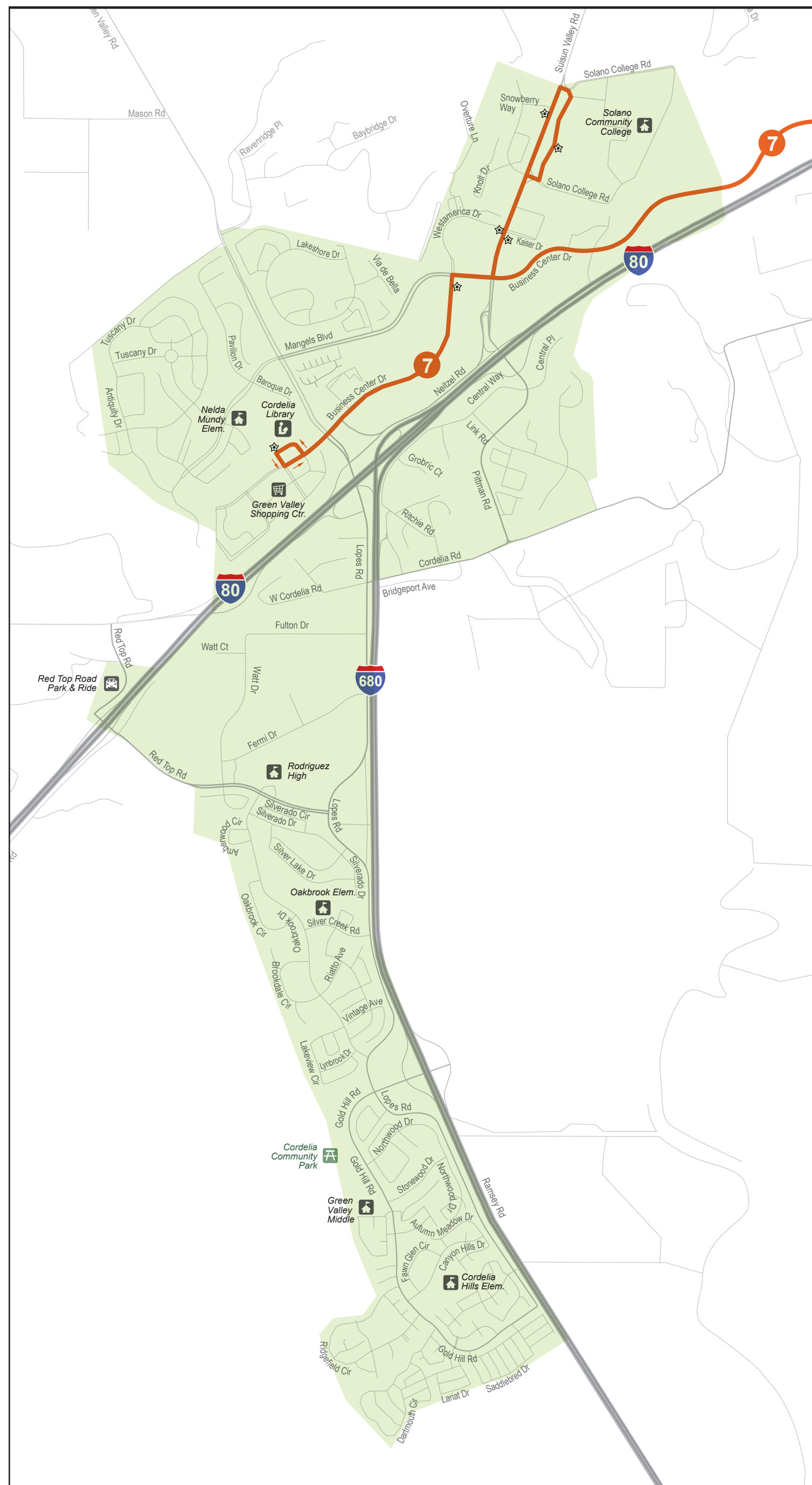

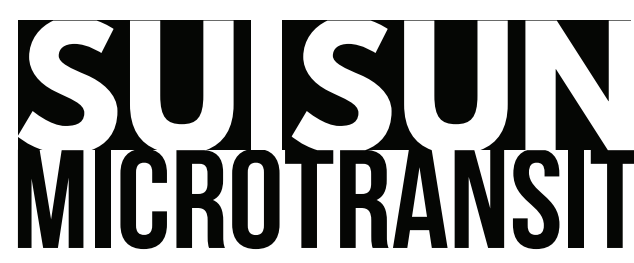

511 Real-Time Departures

511 provides free, up-to-the-minute departure times for the transit agencies to the left that have this symbol. Other Bay Area transit agencies will be added in the future.

To find out when your next bus or train will depart, check nearby displays or simply call 511 and say "Departure Times." You'll then be asked to enter your Stop ID number. If you don't know it, you can say "I don't know," and the system will prompt you to enter your route and stop. 511 will respond with departure times for your route and will also include the Stop ID for future use. You may also look up your stop's ID online at the 511 Transit page (transit.511.org).

511 Salidas en tiempo real

511 proporciona gratuitamente horarios de salida con una precisión de un minuto para las agencias de transporte público que aparecen a la izquierda con este símbolo. En el futuro, se agregarán otras agencias de transporte público del área de la Bahía.

Para saber cuándo saldrá su próximo autobús o tren, vea los carteles cercanos o simplemente llame al 511 y diga "Departure Times" (Horarios de salida). Entonces se le pedirá que ingrese la identificación de su parada (Stop ID). Si no lo sabe, puede decir "I don't know" (No lo sé) y el sistema le pedirá que ingrese su ruta y parada. 511 responderá con los horarios de salida para su ruta y también incluirá la identificación de la parada para su futuro. También puede buscar la identificación de su parada en línea en la página 511 de transporte público (transit.511.org).

Bicycles on Transit

Rail/Ferries: Bicycles are allowed on all Bay Area ferries and nearly all rail lines. Exceptions are San Francisco Muni Metro, historic streetcars, and cable cars.

Buses: Nearly all Bay Area public transit buses are equipped with bicycle racks.

General: While bicycles are allowed on most transit services, there are some space limitations and, in some cases, times when bicycles are not allowed on board. For specific transit operator policies and procedures go to 511.org and click on the bicycling tab, or call 511 and say "bicycling" to speak to an operator who can answer your questions.

Las bicicletas a bordo del transporte público

Ferrocarril/transbordadores (Ferry): Se permiten bicicletas en todos los transbordadores (Ferry) del área de la Bahía y en casi todas las líneas de ferrocarril. El Muni Metro, los tranvías históricos y los tranvías tirados por cable de San Francisco son excepciones.

Autobuses: Casi todos los autobuses de transporte público del área de la Bahía están equipados con porta bicicletas.

General: Aunque se permite llevar bicicletas en la mayoría de los servicios de transporte público, hay ciertas limitaciones de espacio y, en algunos casos, horarios en los que no se permite subir con bicicletas. Para obtener los reglamentos y procedimientos específicos de los operadores de transporte público, vaya a 511.org y haga clic en la pestaña de bicicletas (bicycling), o llame al 511 y diga "bicycling" para hablar con un operador que pueda responder a sus preguntas.

Clipper is the convenient way to pay for transit rides in the Bay Area. The reloadable Clipper card stores value as cash and transit passes to pay your fare on AC Transit, BART, Caltrain, County Connection, Dumbarton Express, FAST, Golden Gate Transit and Ferry, Marin Transit, Muni, SamTrans, San Francisco Bay Ferry, SolTrans, Tri-Delta Transit, Vacaville City Coach, the VINE, VTA, WestCAT and Wheels.

Whether you pay as-you-go with cash or purchase passes or ticket books in advance, Clipper makes commuting easier. Clipper works with a variety of employee transit benefits providers, including Commuter Check®, WageWorks®, and Clipper Direct®.
