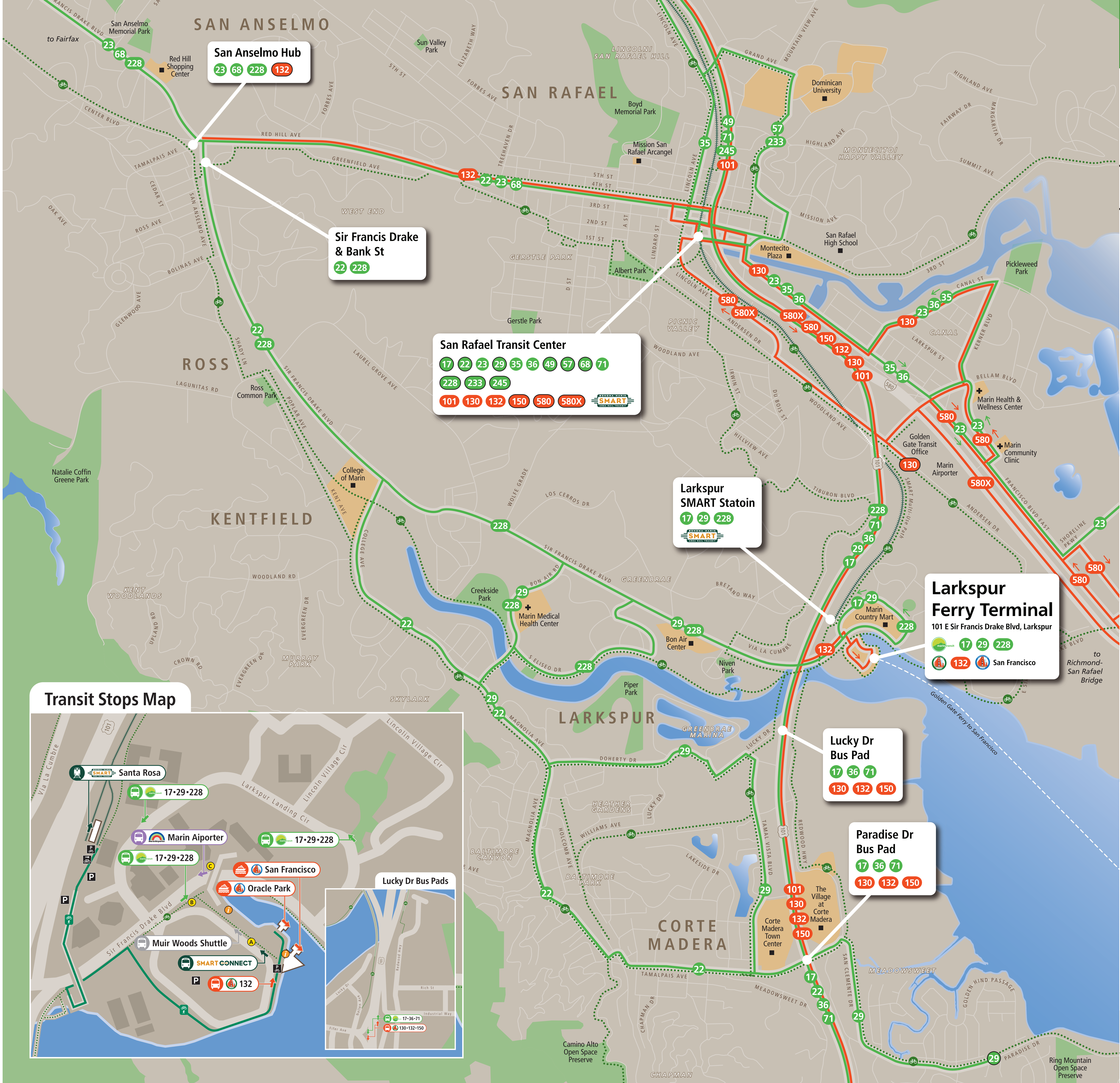

Fare Information

GGT bus fares may be purchased on board. Change will be given on a transit card, valid for future GGT travel. Inform the bus driver of your destination as you board. Golden Gate Ferry tickets may be purchased at ticket vending machines located at the Larkspur Ferry Terminal.

Transfers and Fare Credits

Transfers and fare credits are automatically granted with Clipper®. No transfers for cash-paying customers. Transfers are valid from the time of issuance for:
 • Two hours for travel within a single county or
 • Three hours for inter-county travel
 Transfers can be used to make a round trip within a single county, but cannot be used to make a round trip between counties.
 SMART customers receive a \$1.50 credit (\$7.5 for youth/senior/disabled).
 Marin Transit customers receive a \$3.00 credit (\$1.00 for youth/senior/disabled) for travel within Marin County. Transit fares can also be conveniently paid with your phone using Apple Pay or Google Pay to add Clipper to your mobile wallet.

Fare Information

Fares on Sonoma-Marin Area Rail Transit trains are divided into five zones shown in the table to the right. Fares vary by trip length and the number of zones crossed.
 SMART train fares can be paid using Clipper or SMART eTickets app. Adult Clipper cards can be purchased and fares added at any SMART fare machine. Clipper fares can also be added to a phone using the Clipper mobile wallet.

Clipper®
 Before boarding and after exiting the train, tap the card or phone with Clipper mobile wallet on the card reader located on the station platform.

SMART eTickets App
 Activate your ticket prior to boarding the train. Purchased tickets can be found in the Ticket Wallet on the main screen. Mobile tickets are valid for 90 minutes after activation. Purchased but not activated tickets will expire after a period of 30 days.

SMART CONNECT

The on-demand Larkspur shuttle serves the SMART Larkspur station, Larkspur Ferry Terminal, and the surrounding Larkspur Landing area. On weekends, the shuttle serves the Village and Town Square malls in Corte Madera.
 Shuttle hours:
 • Thursday – Friday: 7:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. and 1:30 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.
 • Saturday – Sunday: 8:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. – 7:30 p.m.
 The shuttle meets every southbound train at the SMART Larkspur train station within 5 minutes.
 Reserve a ride by using the Ride Ping App or by calling 800-727-0279. Seating is limited and reservations are recommended. If space is available, walk-ons are also welcomed.
 Priority is given to people who feel they may not be able to walk between the ferry terminal and the train station.
 Shuttle one-way fares:
 • Adults: \$1.50
 • Persons with a disability: \$0.75
 • Youth (ages 0-18) and seniors (ages 65+): Free
 Fares may be paid cash (no change given), with a credit or debit card in the Ride Ping app.

Personal service assistants are eligible for 50% off the adult cash fare only when accompanying a person with disabilities who has an attendant logo on his/her RTC Discount Card.

Cash Fares
 Full cash fares and 1 Day passes can be purchased with cash onboard vehicles. Change cards valid for future travel are issued for amounts over \$1.00. Change cards have no cash value. Advise the driver of your destination when boarding the bus and ask for a transfer if needed when paying your fare.

Transfers
 A cash fare gives you up to two free transfers on all Marin Transit and Golden Gate Transit buses within Marin County for two hours. Transfers are automatically granted with Clipper.

Clipper
 Clipper cash value can be used on all Marin Transit routes except the Muir Woods Shuttle (Route 66/66F). To ensure you charged the correct fare, tap the card or phone with Clipper mobile wallet on the card reader when entering and exiting the bus.
