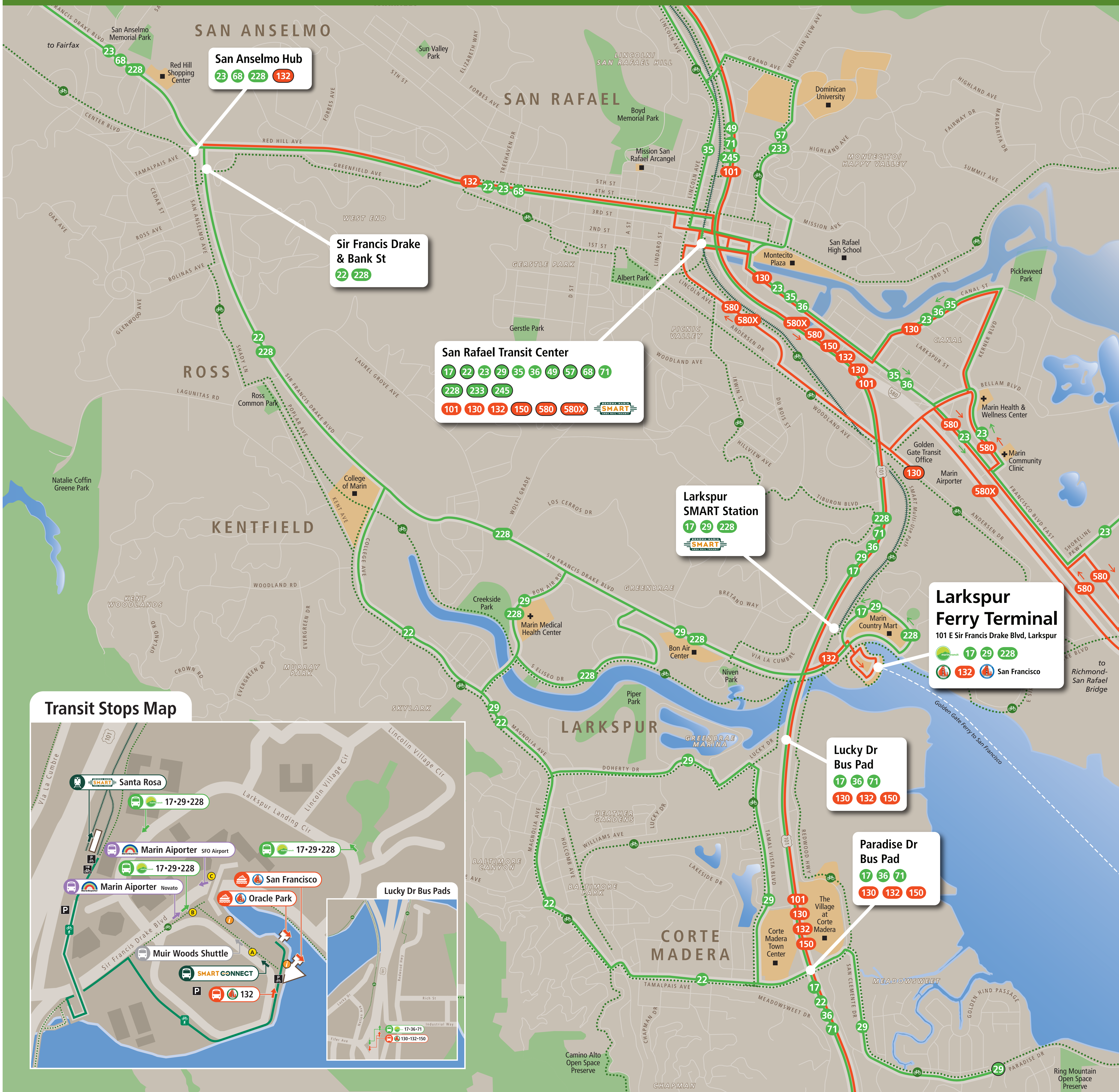

Fare Information

Fares on Golden Gate Transit bus services are divided into fare zones shown in the table below. Fares vary by trip length and the number of zones crossed. GGT bus fares may be purchased on board. Change will be given on a transit card, valid for future GGT travel. Inform the bus driver of your destination as you board. Golden Gate Ferry tickets may be purchased at ticket vending machines located at the Larkspur Ferry Terminal.

Transfers and Fare Credits

Transfers and fare credits automatically granted with Clipper². No transfers for cash-paying customers. Transfers are valid from the time of issuance for: • Two hours for travel within a single county or • Three hours for inter-county travel. Transfers can be used to make a round trip within a single county, but cannot be used to make a round trip between counties. SMART customers receive a \$1.50 credit (\$1.75 for youth/senior/disabled).

Fare Information

effective April 1, 2024

Fares on Sonoma-Marina Area Rail Transit trains are divided into five zones shown in the table to the right. Fares vary by trip length and the number of zones crossed. SMART train fares can be paid using Clipper or SMART eTickets app. Adult Clipper cards can be purchased and fares added at any SMART fare machine. Clipper fares can also be added to a phone using the Clipper mobile wallet.

Transfer Discounts: Passengers who pay with Clipper receive a \$1.50 discount (\$0.75 for youth, seniors and passengers with disabilities) when transferring from Golden Gate Transit, Marin Transit, Petaluma Transit, Santa Rosa Citybus or Sonoma County Transit.

effective November 1, 2022

Fares are for travel within Marin County on Marin Transit and Golden Gate Transit services. Discount fares are available for youth, seniors, persons with disabilities, or by using a Clipper card.

² For the discount you may show a DMV Disabled Placard ID, RTC Discount Card, Medicare Card or ID card for persons with disabilities from another transit service. Personal service assistants are eligible for 50% off the adult cash fare only when accompanying a person with disabilities who has an attendant logo on his/her RTC Discount Card.
³ A valid Clipper Start card is required.

Fare Credits
Full cash fares and 1 Day passes can be purchased with cash onboard vehicles. Change cards valid for future travel are issued for amounts over \$1.00. Change cards have no cash value. Advise the driver of your destination when boarding the bus and ask for a transfer if needed when paying your fare.

Transfers
A cash fare gives you up to two free transfers on all Marin Transit and Golden Gate Transit buses within Marin County for two hours. Transfers are automatically granted with Clipper.

Clipper
Clipper cash value can be used on all Marin Transit routes except the Muir Woods Shuttle (Route 66/66F). To ensure you charged the correct fare, tap the card or phone with Clipper mobile wallet on the card reader when entering and exiting the bus.
