SF Bay Ferry

Alameda Seaplane Route
operates weekdays only between Point Alameda and the San Francisco Ferry Building.

Harbor Bay Route
operates weekdays only between Alameda's Harbor Bay and the San Francisco Ferry Building. No weekend service.

Oakland & Alameda Route
operates daily between Alameda's Main Street, Oakland's Jack London Square, and the San Francisco Ferry Building.

Richmond Route
operates daily between Richmond and the San Francisco Ferry Building.

Vallejo Route
operates daily between the Vallejo Ferry Terminal, Mare Island and the San Francisco Ferry Building.

Passengers should purchase tickets at the Vallejo Ferry Terminal, Pier 41 ticket offices, or at Bay Crossings in the San Francisco Ferry Building – cash, VISA, MasterCard, and Commuter Checks accepted. operates regional bus service daily throughout the day and evening, and Commute bus service during weekday morning and evening commute periods.

Golden Gate Ferry (GGF)

operates daily service between San Francisco and Angel Island, Larkspur, Sausalito and Tiburon.

Fares on Golden Gate Transit bus services are divided into fare zones shown in the table below. Fares vary by trip length and the number of zones crossed. GGT bus fares may be purchased on board. Change will be given on a transit card, valid for future GGT travel. Inform the bus driver of your destination as you board. Discount fares are available for youth, seniors, persons with disabilities, or by using Clipper®.

 • Three hours for inter-county travel
