- Alameda Seaplane Route** operates weekdays only between Point Alameda and the San Francisco Ferry Building.
- Harbor Bay Route** operates weekdays only between Alameda's Harbor Bay and the San Francisco Ferry Building. No weekend service.
- Oakland & Alameda Route** operates daily between Alameda's Main Street, Oakland's Jack London Square, and the San Francisco Ferry Building.
- Richmond Route** operates daily between Richmond and the San Francisco Ferry Building.
- Vallejo Route** operates daily between the Vallejo Ferry Terminal, Mare Island and the San Francisco Ferry Building.

Fare Information effective July 1, 2021

Passengers should purchase tickets at the Vallejo Ferry Terminal, Pier 41 ticket offices, or at Bay Crossings in the San Francisco Ferry Building - cash, VISA, MasterCard, and Commuter Checks accepted. One-way tickets may be purchased using the Hopthru mobile ticketing app and onboard by cash or credit card.

Golden Gate Transit (GGT) operates Regional bus service daily throughout the day and evening, and Commute bus service during weekday morning and evening commute periods.

Golden Gate Ferry (GGF) operates daily service between San Francisco and Angel Island, Larkspur, Sausalito and Tiburon.

Fare Information effective January 1, 2024

Fares on Golden Gate Transit bus services are divided into fare zones shown in the table below. Fares vary by trip length and the number of zones crossed.

GGT bus fares may be purchased on board. Change will be given on a transit card, valid for future GGT travel. Inform the bus driver of your destination as you board.

Discount fares are available for youth, seniors, persons with disabilities, or by using Clipper®.

Transfers

Ask for a transfer before paying fare. Transfers are valid from the time of issuance for:

- Two hours for travel within a single county or
- Three hours for inter-county travel

Transfers can be used to make a round trip within a single county but cannot be used to make a round trip between counties. Transfers automatically granted with Clipper®.

Transferring from Ferry to Bus

Customers not using Clipper® must pay upon boarding the bus. Transfers automatically granted with Clipper®.
