

Am I Toll Exempt?

Carpools, vanpools, commute buses, motorcycles, and eligible clean air vehicles (CAV) can drive in Bay Area Express Lanes for free or pay half-price tolls with a FasTrak Flex® toll tag or a FasTrak CAV toll tag.

Motorcycle – Motorcycles travel toll free with FasTrak Flex® on all express lanes. FasTrak Flex® toll tag must be set to 3+ people.



Vanpools – Vanpools consist of 7 or more riders, including the driver. For more information on how to start or join a vanpool, [click here](#).



Clean Air Vehicle – Clean Air Vehicles with valid decals travel toll free or pay half-price tolls as shown in the table. To learn about CAV decals, [click here](#).
