Northbound U.S. 101 Overnight Closure for Overhead Sign Replacement Work in San Mateo County

Closure Detour:

Motorists will be directed to exit at the East Hillsdale Boulevard Off-Ramp, in the City of **San Mateo**. Motorists will then be able to choose between two detour routes, diverging east (shown in green) and west (shown in blue), to either return to northbound U.S. 101, or reach their destination.

Southbound U.S. 101 traffic will be unaffected.

During this closure, the following freeway ramps will be closed:

- Northbound U.S. 101 On-Ramp from East Hillsdale Boulevard
- SR 92 Connector Ramps from Northbound U.S. 101

Changeable message and directional signs will be in place to assist motorists traveling in the area. The California Highway Patrol (CHP) will be on site during the closures.

Please drive with caution. Slow for the Cone Zone and Be Work Zone Alert. Caltrans thanks motorists for their patience while we work to maintain our state's highways, bridges, and tunnels.
