SAN FRANCISCO – Caltrans has scheduled overnight lane and full highway closures for barrier construction work next week in the overnight hours from 8:00 PM to 6:00 AM on Northbound and Southbound U.S.101 (101) over the Alemany Deck from Monday, May 11 to Saturday, May 16. Caltrans regrets any inconvenience as residents may experience some noise. CHP will be on-site to guide and assist motorists for the closures and detours.
