Daytime Full Closure of Northbound, Southbound State Route 1 (SR-1) for Tree Removal, Cleanup Between Tomales and Marshall in West Marin

Schedule: Monday, April 8 between 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m.

MARIN COUNTY — Caltrans maintenance is scheduled to continue tree removal and cleanup on Northbound and Southbound State Route (SR-1) in between Tomales and Marshall in the western portion of the county. The highway is scheduled to be fully closed **Monday, April 8** between **8:30 a.m.** and **4:30 p.m.** due to the need for a large crane.

Drivers should take Tomales Petaluma Road to Marshall and then loop back onto SR-1.

Caltrans is removing large, uprooted Eucalyptus trees that were affected by the recent storms.

Changeable message and directional signs will be in place to assist motorists traveling in the area.

Please drive with caution. Slow for the Cone Zone and Be Work Zone Alert.
