**Northbound State Route 242 (SR-242) Between the Northbound
Interstate 680 (I-680) Split and The Market Street On-Ramp-Concord
Tuesday, August 17 through Friday, August 20
12:00 AM until 6:00 AM
Four Consecutive Nights
Overnight Full Highway Closure**

CONTRA COSTA COUNTY – Caltrans will replace slabs of pavement along northbound SR-242, in Concord, between the northbound I-680 split and the Market Street on-ramp.

The work is scheduled from Tuesday, August 17 until Friday, August 20. During work hours, a full overnight highway closure will be in effect each night along northbound SR-242 between the northbound I-680 split and the Market Street on-ramp to SR-242 from 12:00 AM until 6:00 AM.

Detour: During this closure detour signs will be posted; motorists will be directed to use the northbound I-680 Willow Pass Road off-ramp and continue east. Motorists will then be directed to eastbound on Market Street and continue onto the on-ramp back to SR-242.

Motorists should expect delays and watch for detour signs.
