Schedule: Friday January 10th at 8 PM Northbound and Saturday January 11th at midnight Southbound.

CONTRA COSTA COUNTY—

Caltrans has scheduled oneway traffic control on the Antioch Bridge (SR-160) **Friday night January 10th** from **8 p.m. until 4 a.m.**

Northbound SR-160 from the Antioch Toll Plaza to the North end of the bridge will be closed from 8 PM to 11:59 PM on January 10th, 2025. Traffic will be able to flow Northbound in the Southbound Lane when clear by flaggers holding traffic coming Southbound at the North End of the Bridge.

Southbound SR-160 from the North End of the bridge to the Antioch Toll Plaza will be closed

Southbound in the Northbound Lane when clear by flaggers holding traffic coming Northbound at the South End of the Bridge.

The closure will extend the entire length of the bridge.

A pilot car will be implimented and the speed will be restricted to 25 mph in the work zone.

Caltrans will turn on Changeable Message Signs (CMS) to notify the public ahead of time.
