AM I TOLL-EXEMPT?

Carpools, vanpools, commute buses, motorcycles and eligible clean air vehicles can drive in Bay Area Express Lanes for free or pay reduced tolls as long as they follow express lane tag rules.

Commute Bus – Public and private buses can use the express lane as long as they are either a 'commute bus' or meet vehicle occupancy requirements. For the definition of 'commute bus', [click here](#).



Motorcycle – Motorcycles travel toll free with FasTrak Flex on all express lanes.



Clean Air Vehicle – Clean Air Vehicles with valid decals travel toll free or pay half-price tolls as shown in the table. The table shows which lanes require FasTrak CAV toll tags. [click here](#).
